

# MODERN SLAVERY AND HUMAN TRAFFICKING STATEMENT

## **Introduction**

This statement is made pursuant to section 54(1) of the Modern Slavery Act 2015 and constitutes Propensio Finance's ("the Company") slavery and human trafficking statement.

The Company recognises that the risks of modern slavery exist, and that modern slavery encompasses slavery, servitude, human trafficking and forced labour. Although the Company is not obliged under the scope of the Modern Slavery Act 2015 to publish a statement, we are committed to ensuring that there is none within our business or within our sub-contractor network, and as far as is practical, that our suppliers are also committed to its eradication. This statement sets out the steps we have taken and our ongoing commitment to achieving this.

This Modern Slavery and Human Trafficking Statement relates to actions and activities during the financial year 01/10/2025 to 30/09/2026.

### **Our Suppliers**

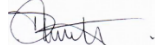

Where there is any concern regarding a supplier's behaviour, the business relationship will be terminated.

We will assess the effectiveness of the steps we are taking to ensure that slavery and/or human trafficking is not taking place within our business or supply chain by monitoring whether any reports are received from employees, the public, or law enforcement agencies indicating that modern slavery practices have been identified.
